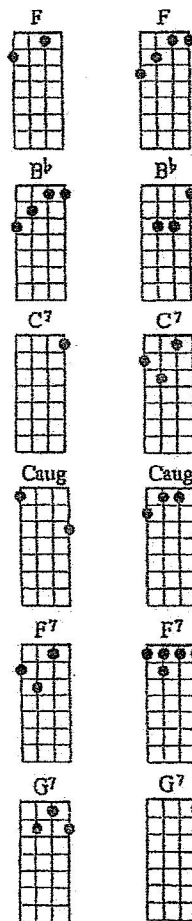


# Jingle Bells

F F7 Bb  
Dashing through the snow in a one-horse open sleigh  
C7 F  
O'er the fields we go laughing all the way  
F7 Bb  
Bells on bob-tail ring making spirits bright  
C7 F (C+)  
What fun it is to ride and sing a sleighing song tonight.

2x at  
end*  
F F7  
Jingle bells, jingle bells, jingle all the way  
Bb F G7 C7 C+  
Oh what fun it is to ride in a one-horse open sleigh  
F F7  
Jingle bells, jingle bells, jingle all the way  
Bb F C7 F (C7 F) *end*  
Oh what fun it is to ride in a one-horse open sleigh *repeat, 1st time at end*

F Bb  
A day or two ago, I thought I'd take a ride  
C7 F  
And soon Miss Fannie Bright was seated by my side.  
Bb  
The horse was lean and lank, misfortune seemed his lot.  
C7 F (C+)  
We ran in to a drifted bank and there we got upsot.

A day or two ago, the story I must tell,  
C7 F  
I went out on the snow, and on my back I fell.  
Bb  
A gent was riding by in a one-horse open sleigh.  
C7 F (C+)  
He laughed at me as I there laid, but quickly rode away.~~

F Bb  
Now the ground is white, go it while you're young.  
C7 F  
Take the girls along, and sing this sleighing song.  
Bb  
Just get a bobtailed nag, two-forty for his speed.  
C7 F (C+)  
Then hitch him to an open sleigh, and crack, you'll take the lead.
