Where the laulau is the kau kau at the big luau.

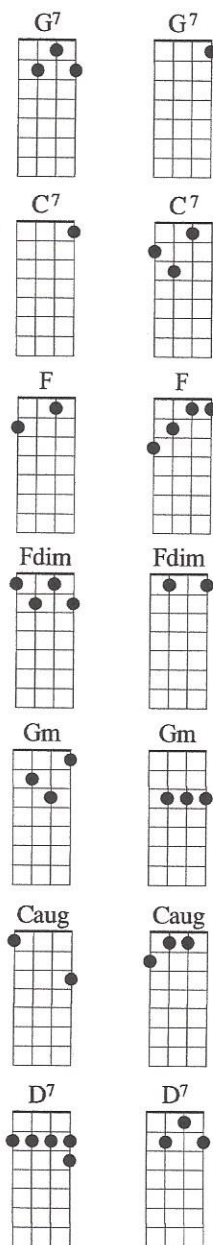
We'll throw our nets out into the sea,
