Bridge 1:

I got a hot-rod Ford and a two-dollar bill

F C

And I know a spot right over the hill.

F C

There's soda pop and the dancin's free,

D7\\ G7

So if you wanna have fun come along with me.

C

Say, hey, good lookin', whatcha got cookin'?

D7 G7 C G7

How's about cookin' somethin' up with me?

C

I'm free and ready, so we can go steady.

D7 G7 C G7

How's about savin' all your time for me?

C

No more lookin', I know I've been taken.

D7 G7 C C7

How's about keepin' steady company?

F C

Bridge 2: I'm gonna throw my date-book over the fence

F C

And find me one for five or ten cents.

F C

I'll keep it 'til it's covered with age

D7\\ G7

'Cause I'm writin' your name down on every page

C

Sayin', Hey, good lookin', whatcha got cookin'?

D7 G7 C

How's about cookin' somethin' up with (3X). me?

1st time: C7 (return to Bridge 2)
2nd time: tag last line 2x, end with G7 C
